

On Wednesday, April 9th, the Faith Community of Saint Sabina is calling for a day of prayer, fasting and action (Matthew 17:21).

PRAYER: We are asking all to intentionally pray throughout the day for our country and for all those who are suffering from loss of jobs, inflation, for Democracy to be restored, and for our elected leadership to make decisions with a morality and conscientousness for the poor and vulnerable and respect the rights and dignity of all people.

Join us for 1 hour of corporate prayer from 7:30pm-8:30pm in the sanctuary.

FASTING: We are asking all to join in a corporate Day of Fasting. There are different types of fasts. Please choose one that best fits your health and ability. WARRIOR - Consuming one meal in the evening after fasting from dawn to dusk PARTIAL - Refraining from certain types of foods such as fast food, fried food, etc. WATER/JUICE - Consuming only water or juices during the fasting period

<u>ACTION</u>: We are asking all to call, email, or send a letter to the Democratic Congressional and Senatorial offices demanding that they speak out and fight back on this abuse of power in the current administration.
